Prayer works.

#### **The Lord's Prayer**


#### **The Tabernacle Prayer**

In the Old Testament, the Tabernacle was the dwelling place of God, built to His specifications, where He would meet His people. As they entered the Tabernacle, they passed through seven stations, following God's instructions, to experience His presence. Today, even though we no longer need the physical Tabernacle to meet with God, these same steps can help us connect with Him.

Begin by writing about blessings in your life for which you're thankful for. Thank God for the power and healing that the cross and resurrection of Jesus gives you. Confess your sins to Him and receive complete forgiveness and a fresh start. Thank God for the Holy Spirit that lives inside of you. Read Romans 12 then praise and worship God. End by interceding on behalf of those around you.

#### **Praying Scripture**

Praying Scripture is one of the most powerful things you can do because you are proclaiming the Truth that is living and active. Pray and ask God to search your heart. Ask him to find anything in you that is offensive, and to help you remove it from your life. Repent and forgive. Pray that He would teach you to love others and live a life that points people to Him. "SEARCH ME, GOD, AND KNOW MY HEART; AND TEST ME KNOW MY ANXIOUS THOUGHTS. SEE IF THERE IS ANY OFFENSIVE WAY IN ME, AND LEAD ME IN THE EVERLASTING." PSALM 139:23-24

#### **The Prayer of Jabez**

Begin by asking God boldly, with the right heart, for His blessing. Not simply His physical blessing but emotional and mental as well. You do not have, because you do not ask. Pray for more influence. In humility, acknowledge your need for God's presence. Finally ask and trust the Lord to protect you. "JABEZ CRIED OUT TO THE GOD OF ISRAEL, "OH, THAT YOU WOULD BLESS ME AND ENLARGE MY TERRITORY! LET YOUR HAND BE WITH ME, AND KEEP ME FROM HARM SO THAT I WILL BE FREE FROM PAIN." AND GOD GRANTED HIS REQUEST." 1 CHRONICLES 4:10

#### **Warfare Prayers**

Every time the enemy tried to tempt Him, Jesus responded with a reference from the Bible. Acknowledge that you're in a spiritual battle. Whether lies, fear or anxiety - you can command anything that comes against the truth of God and His Word to bow to the name of Jesus. Take a bold stand, praying specifically and confidently through God's power and His Spirit. "THE WEAPONS WE FIGHT WITH ARE NOT THE WEAPONS OF THE WORLD. ON THE CONTRARY, THEY HAVE DIVINE POWER TO DEMOLISH STRONGHOLDS. WE DEMOLISH ARGUMENTS AND EVERY PRETENSION THAT SETSITSELF UP AGAINST THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD, AND WE TAKE CAPTIVEEVERY THOUGHT TO MAKE IT OBEDIENT TO CHRIST." 2 CORINTHIANS 10:4-5

#### Psalm 23 Prayer

Pray in sequence by thanking God in advance for who He is and how He will show up in your life:

He's my shepherd (vs 1), He's my provider (vs 1), He's my peace (vs 2), He's my healer (vs 3), He's my righteousness (vs 3), He's my friend (vs 4).



"THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD; I SHALL NOT WANT. HE MAKES ME LIE DOWN IN GREEN PASTURES. HE LEADS ME BESIDE STILL WATERS. HE RESTORES MY SOUL. HE LEADS ME IN PATHS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS FOR HIS NAME'S SAKE. EVEN THOUGH I WALK THROUGH THE VALLEY OF THE SHADOW OF DEATH, I WILL FEAR NO EVIL, FOR YOU ARE WITH ME; YOUR ROD AND YOUR STAFF, THEY COMFORT ME"

#### Psalm 23 Prayer (Continued)

Pray in sequence by thanking God in advance for who He is and how He will show up in your life:

He's my defender (vs 5), He's my sanctifier (v 5), He's my banner of goodness (vs 6), He's my safe dwelling place forevermore (vs 6).

"YOU PREPARE A TABLE BEFORE ME IN THE PRESENCE OF MY ENEMIES; YOU ANOINT MY HEAD WITHOIL; MY CUP OVERFLOWS. SURELY GOODNESS AND MERCY SHALL FOLLOW ME ALL THEDAYS OF MY LIFE, AND I SHALL DWELL IN THE HOUSE OF THELORD FOREVER."
